CURRICULUM FEEDBACK SURVEY - STUDENTS



Fairness of evaluation The evaluation process and transparency in the system is well applauded by 76.4 % of the students.



Laboratory and clinical facilities

Efforts are taken by the institution/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make the students ready for the world of work and it was appreciated to a great extent by 95.1% of students.

Leadership qualities 75 % of students responses were the content of the syllabus helpful in developing professional ethics leadership qualities and environmental awareness



CURRICULUM FEEDBACK SURVEY - FACULTY
