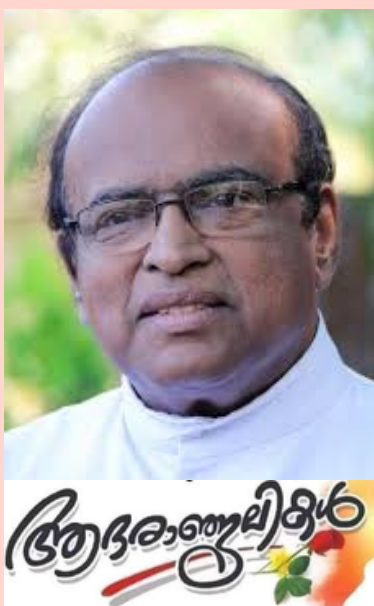


Principal's Desk

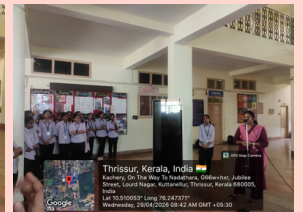

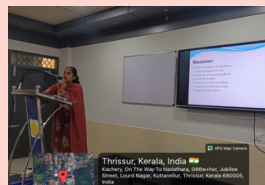
