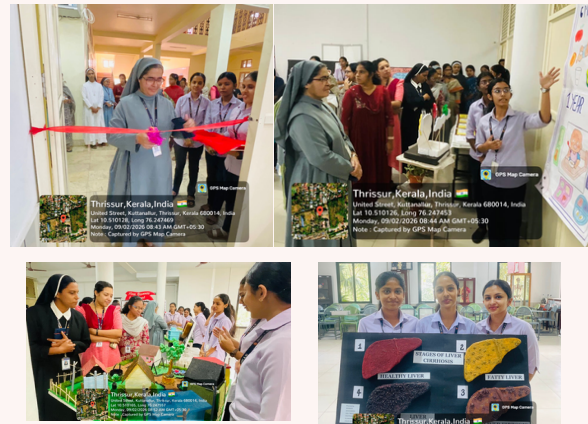

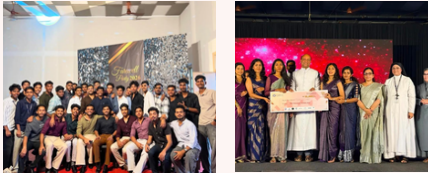

### "Farewell Nursing Batch 2026: Memories to Cherish, Bonds to Last 😊☀️"

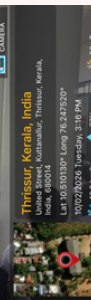
