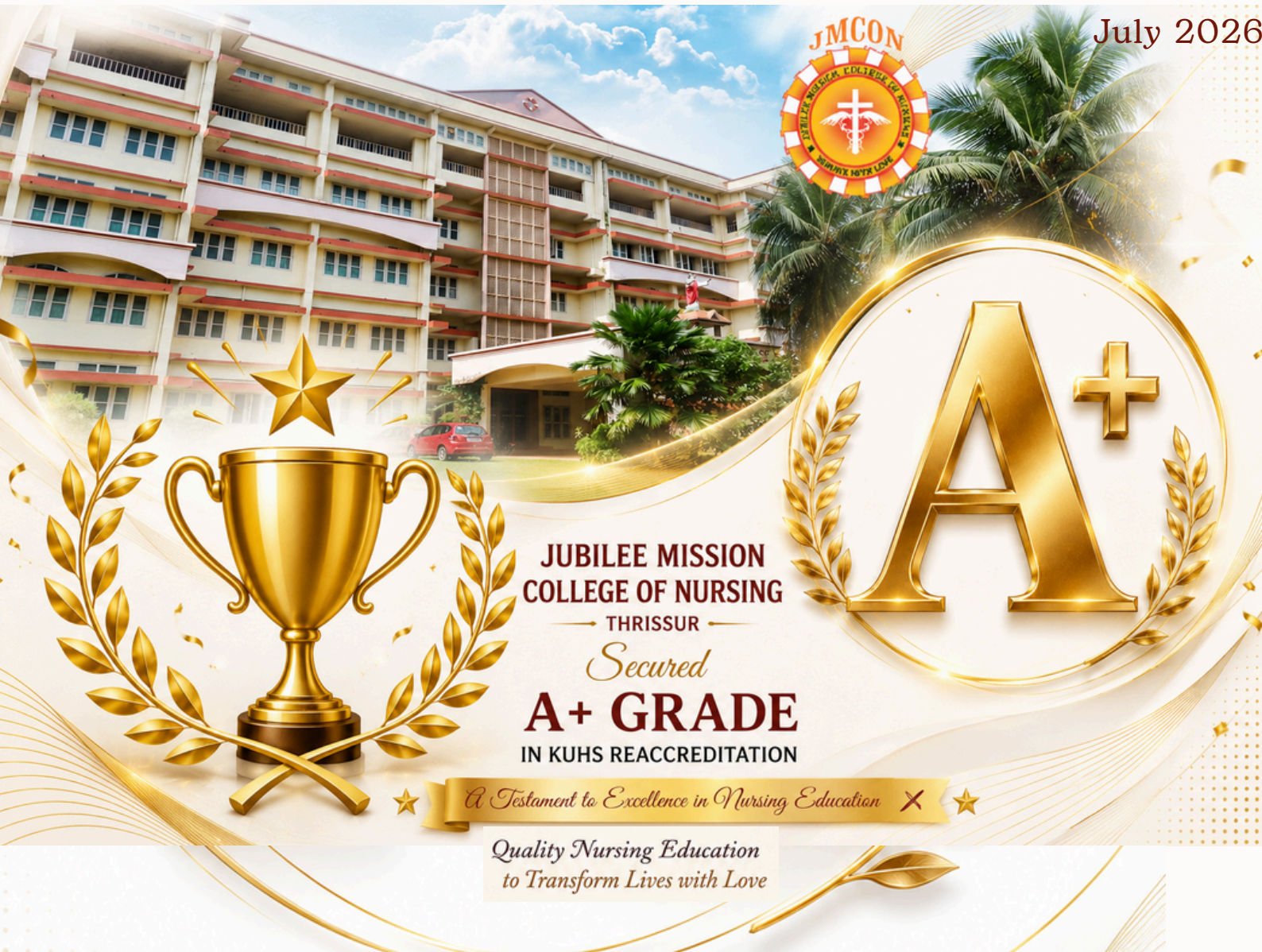

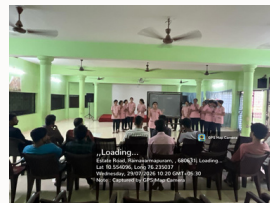

Artificial Intelligence in Nursing Education: Opportunities and Challenges

Opportunities in Nursing Education

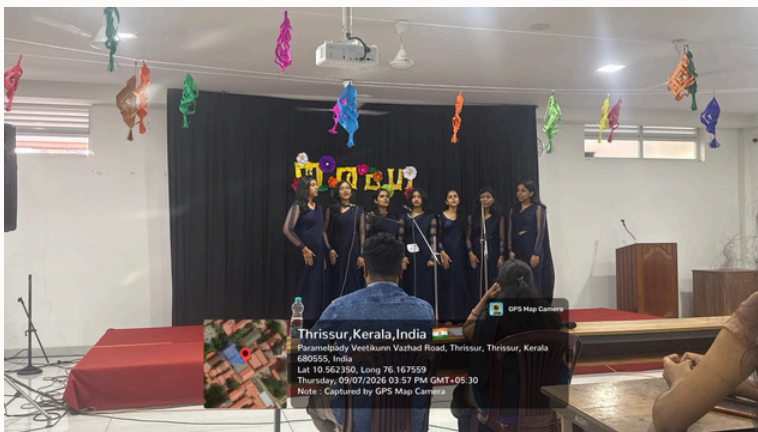
